NINE (9) DAYS TOUR SAFARI

The accommodation is full board throughout the safari starting with lunch on day 1 and finishing with breakfast on day 9.

During the safari, there is a chance to do extra activities apart from the usual game viewing. The extra activities are charged separately but are not included in the prices given. They include:

1. Visit to Maasai villages for cultural experience in Maasai Mara - \$30 per person
2. Hot air balloon ride in Maasai Mara - \$450 per person and this includes the 1-hour flight and a champagne bush breakfast after landing
3. Night game drive in Ol Pejeta Conservancy - \$40 per person
4. Guided bush walks in Ol Pejeta - \$40 per person
5. Lion tracking in Ol Pejeta - \$40 per person
6. Endangered species enclosure where there is the last 2 remaining northern white rhinos in the world - \$40 per person.
7. Horse riding with the endangered rhinos - \$40 per person but only for experienced riders.

Extra lunch box on the way will cost \$30 per lunch box; prior notice must be a day before.

The vehicle is privately allocated to the group during the safari unless otherwise.

It will be a private guided safari and there will be no one to join the group during the safari.

The clients will choose to book plane tickets themselves or we can plan and book the whole travel.

Please note: November to March are dry months in Kenya with very little to no chances of rain, June to August are high season travel to Kenya.

All visitors' visas can be acquired at the airport on arrival for \$50 per person therefore there will be no need of getting visas before your arrival.

TRAVEL ITINERARY

1. Northern circuit – (north of Nairobi)

NORTHERN CIRCUIT

This tour starts from Nairobi towards Northern Frontier district whose climate is dry and harsh (semi-arid) but with a very beautiful landscape, the trip takes from the swampy Nairobi outlook to dry semi-arid area through Mount Kenya and down to the Rift Valley before ending back in Nairobi. The itinerary is as follows:

Day 1 - Pick up at the airport and drop off at hotel or Guest house, freshen up then have breakfast. Take a 3hour drive to Buffalo Springs National Park, Samburu. Buffalo Springs National Park is home to the rare and exotic wildlife species such as the gerenuk, Rothschild giraffe, gray's zebra, endangered Samburu monkeys, Beisa Oryx and large elephant herds. Stop at the equator for photo session. Arrive at Samburu in time for Check in. Spend the rest of the day at your own leisure.

Overnight at Ashnil Samburu Camp

Meals Plan: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Day 2 - Samburu Buffalo springs game reserve

Spend full day within this reserve viewing wildlife, birds enjoying the natural ecosystem that exists within the park as you view and take photos of the scenic landscape which makes up the park. The park also offers optional rides on the back of a camel under the guidance of a professional camel guide. If you so wish you may visit the Samburu villages for a cultural visit and spend some time with the hospitable and colorfully decorated Moran's amidst traditional songs and dances.

Overnight at Ashnil Samburu Camp.

Meals Plan: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner



Day 3 - Samburu to Ol Pejeta Conservancy in Laikipia

After breakfast check out from Ashnil Samburu Camp and depart to Ol Pejeta Conservancy arriving on time for lunch at Ol Pejeta. After lunch, relax before setting out on an exciting afternoon game drive in conservancy. This is East Africa's largest black rhino sanctuary, the only place in Kenya with chimpanzees and holds some of the highest predator densities in Kenya.

Guests can engage in extra activities upon request and at an extra cost. Such activities include game walks, night game drives, horseback, guided bush walks, lion tracking, bird watching, game viewing from blinds, game rides and meals in the bush and camel rides. Ol Pejeta Conservancy is a beautiful private game reserve and home to rare species such as a x, Rothschild's giraffe and black rhino. Game drives in this reserve reveal the full range of

African Wildlife including lion, leopard, cheetah, elephant and hippo. Enjoy a private visit with the tame animals at the wildlife orphanage. Observe chimps at the chimpanzee sanctuary as well.

Overnight at Sweetwater's Tented Camp.

Meals Plan: Lunch and Dinner.

Day 4 - Ol Pejeta Conservancy

An early morning game drive in the conservancy with the big five; lion, elephant, African buffalo, leopard and rhinoceros (either the white or black rhinoceros).

Combination of amazing wildlife and stunning views across the open plains of Ol Pejeta guarantees an unforgettable safari experience.

Overnight at Sweetwater's Tented Camp.

Meals Plan: Lunch and Dinner.

Day 5 - Ol Pejeta to Lake Nakuru National park

Breakfast then check out from the lodge. The guest sets off towards the stunning scenery of Kenya's Great Rift Valley checking into Sarova Lion Hill Lodge for a day. After lunch, they head out to explore Lake Nakuru National Park.

Lake Nakuru National Park is famous for the spectacular pink flamingos that gather on its salt encrusted shores as well as for other bird species including African fish eagles and pelicans. The woodland and grassland surrounding the soda Lake are home to an abundance of wildlife including black rhino, white rhino, hippo, leopard, lion and the rare Rothschild giraffe.

Overnight at Sarova Lion Hill Lodge

Meal plan: Lunch and Dinner



Day 6 - Lake Nakuru National park to Maasai Mara game reserve

After early breakfast, check out from the Lodge and continue with the safari to the world famous Maasai Mara, arriving for lunch at Ashnil Mara Camp for a 2 day stay.

The activities at the lodge involve observing wildlife from the elephant deck or at the hippo bar overlooking a waterhole.

Alternatively, enjoy the swimming pool or other optional activities (payable locally) such as the spa or nature walks. In the afternoon enjoy a game drive in the Mara Reserve.

Overnight at Ashnil Mara Camp.

Meal plan: Lunch, Dinner.

Day 7 - Maasai Mara national reserve

Early breakfast at the lodge followed by a morning game drive in the Masai Mara National Reserve. Later have lunch at the camp. Enjoy another game drive in the Reserve in the afternoon.

Expect to see varieties of wild animals in Kenya, both great and small, such as elephants, buffaloes, giraffes and antelopes among others. This reserve is home to the famous big cats in the region.

Overnight at Ashnil Mara Camp

Meal Plan: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner



Cost/person: \$ 1,150

Day 8 - Maasai Mara national reserve to Nairobi

After breakfast check out from the lodge and travel back to Nairobi for 2 nights stay at Fifth Generation Guest Wing. Spend the rest of the day at your own leisure and have a feel of the warm serene environment.

Overnight at Fifth Generation Guest Wing.

Meals Plan: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner.

Day 9-drop off at the airport

After breakfast, the guest is free to choose to visit different places in Nairobi for instance, The Giraffe Centre, animal orphanage, Kenya National Museum among others.

THE PRICE OF THE SAFARI INCLUDES

- All applicable game park entrance fees
- Full board accommodation as indicated in the itinerary (breakfast, lunch and dinner)
- Drinking water.
- Airport pick up on arrival in Nairobi.
- Transport by private 4x4 Land Cruiser.

THE PRICES OF THE SAFARI EXCLUDES

- International flights from home and back.
- Cost of obtaining passport and visas.
- Personal expenses such as travelling insurance, excess baggage fee, communication charges that include laundry, emails, faxes, phone calls beverages including luxury champagne, luxury spirits beer, wines during meals or meals not indicated in the itinerary.
- Tips and portorage.
- Tour in Nairobi.

This option will be the most scenic and most diverse when it comes to landscapes and wildlife.

There is a higher chance of seeing all the big 5 animals plus lots of other different species of wildlife and birds. It mixes savanna grasslands, mountains, arid regions and lakes.

Note: Ol Pejeta Conservancy is a home to chimpanzees and the last two remaining northern white rhino species. You will also get a chance to feed a blind rhino called Baraka (meaning blessings in Swahili).
